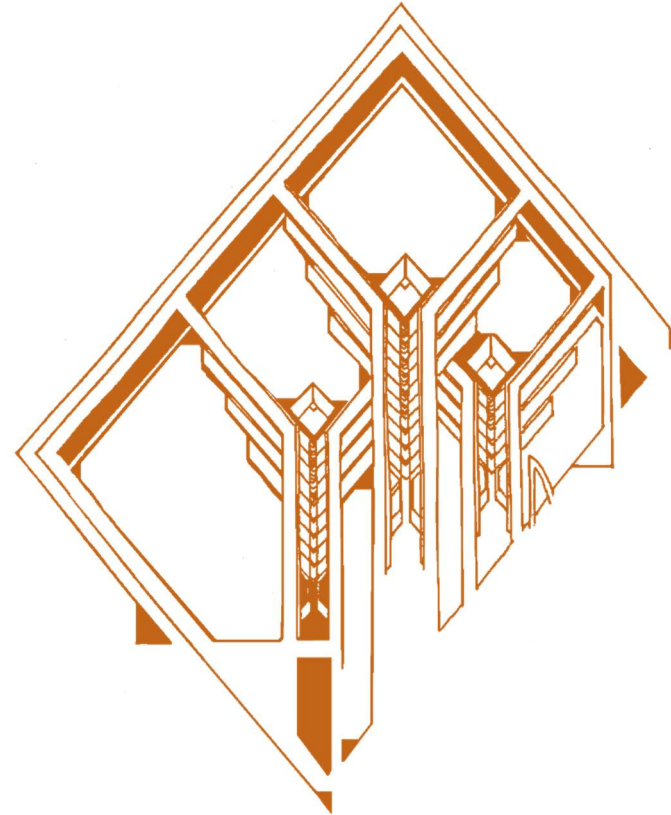

News Sheet for the Porterville Seventh-day Adventist Church

DIRECTIONS TO EARL PEARSON'S HOME:

Take highway **190** from Porterville to **Springville**.

After passing through Springville, turn **left** at the **white barn** onto **Balch Park Road**.

Drive approximately **6 miles** passing Bear Creek Road on the right and Harris Road on the right.

Watch for a sign to Visalia just before you **turn left** on to **Yokohl Valley Road**.

After turning left on Yokohl, watch your speedometer closely and drive **1.5 miles**.

Earl Pearson's driveway will be on your **left**, (**address 41775 Yokohl Valley Road**) where there will be a **balloon** noting the driveway. Drive 3/10 of a mile on a gravel road to his gate on the left. (address will be on his gate also). From the gate to his house is 0.4 miles.
